

1. Precrease along the diagonal with a mountain fold.

2. Valley fold the sides to the center.

3. Valley fold the corner to the dotted crease. Allow the flap from behind to flip out.

4. Valley fold the corner to the dotted intersection of creases.

5. Mountain fold the corner behind.

6. Swing the flap back to the previous position.

7. Precrease along the existing creases (adding new folds on the top flap).

8. Reverse fold along the existing creases.

9. Valley fold towards the bottom corner, allowing the rear flap to flip out.

10. Precrease the middle along the angle bisector.

11. Valley fold the corner down.

12. Swing over the top flap.

13. Valley fold through the dotted intersection of creases.

14. Squash fold over along the center.

15. Valley fold down, allowing the hidden flap to squash fold flat.

16. Pull out the middle layer.

17. Bring the corner to the top, allowing the sides to spread apart and lie flat.

18. Pull out the trapped corner.

19. Swing the flap up.

20. Valley fold the flap up.

21. Swing the flap down.

22. Valley fold over while squash folding the corner.

23. Valley fold along the angle bisector.

24. Reverse fold the flap up.

25. Squash fold the flap.

26. Valley fold the flap over.

27. Swivel fold the side inside.

28. Valley fold up, starting a small amount above $1 / 3$ rd the height of the flap.

29. Mountain fold the corner.

30. Pleat the flap so it lies symmetrically.

31. Valley fold the corner to the bottom edge.

32. Tuck the flap underneath the top layer.

33. Mountain fold the flap so it aligns with the dotted corner of the hidden flap.

34. Bring the bottom flap to the surface.

35. Mountain fold the corners inside.

36. Mountain fold the corner inside.

37. Mountain fold the flaps inside, tapering the folds as desired.
