





Questions asked to Origami-Dan Discord server in 2021: ->How do you feel about using cuts in origami? Would you be willing to use them yourself?


- "Personally I wouldn't do it because people are more impressed when you tell them no cuts"

- "I ABSOLUTELY DONT' cut in origami! Unless the diagrams ask me to do so, in which case I do"















Squares Lattice - 2021






