





Paper Recommendation

8 right angled isosceles triangular units. Cut along the diagonals of the Kami / duo / patterned

square to obtain the triangular units.




Alternatively, the units can be pre-creased, but it is not necessary. However, to do that, fold each unit till step 3 of Assembly; and then continue assembling as shown.




1. Take 2 units at 45° to each other. Wrap the second unit over the first.




3. This is how it looks. Fold the flap down. Mountain fold along the crease marked.



2. Gently lift the flap on the left and fold along the crease marked.




4. This is how it looks. Turn over.




7. The third unit is now joined. Turn over.
