Magic Duo Color Box

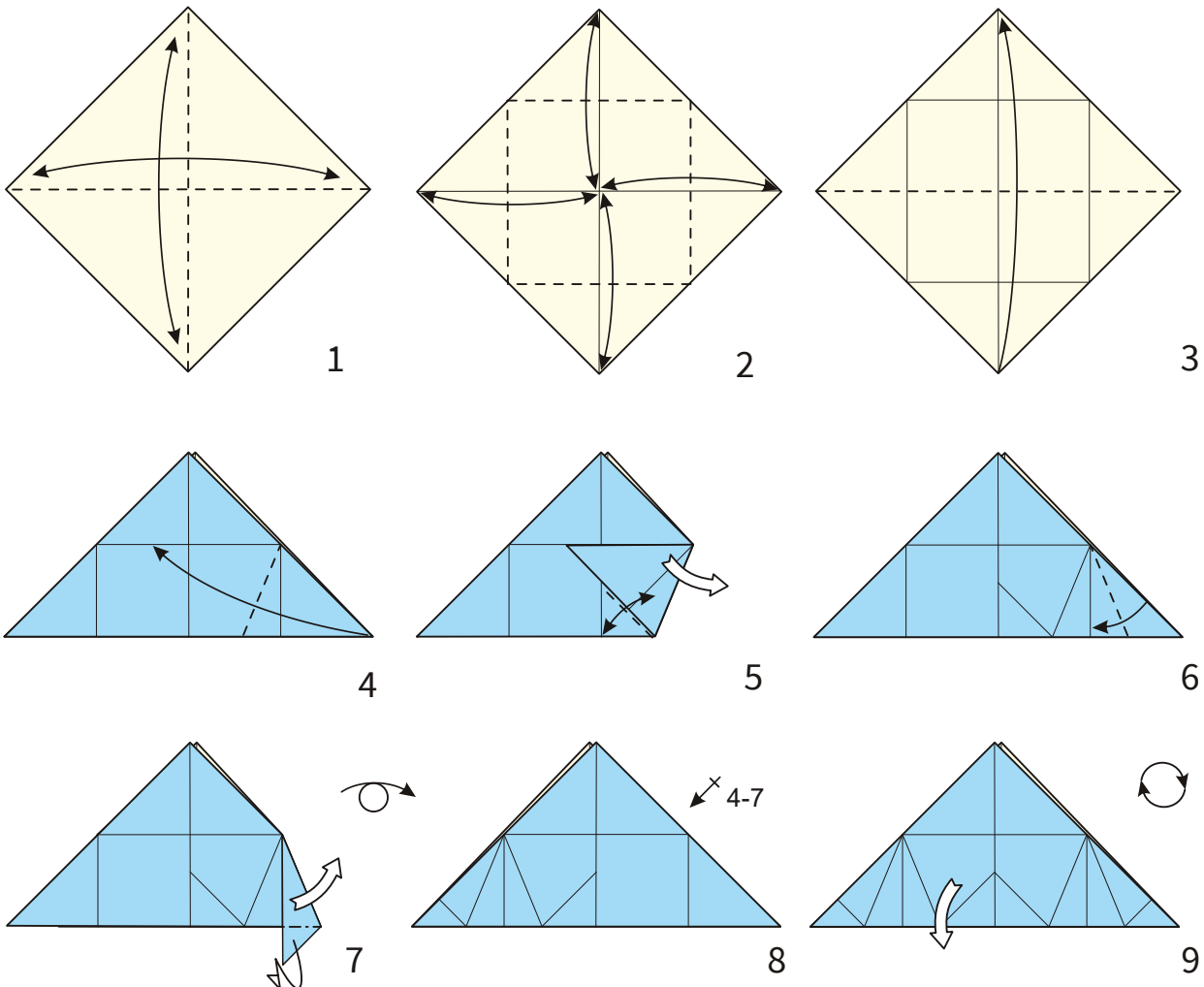
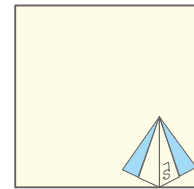

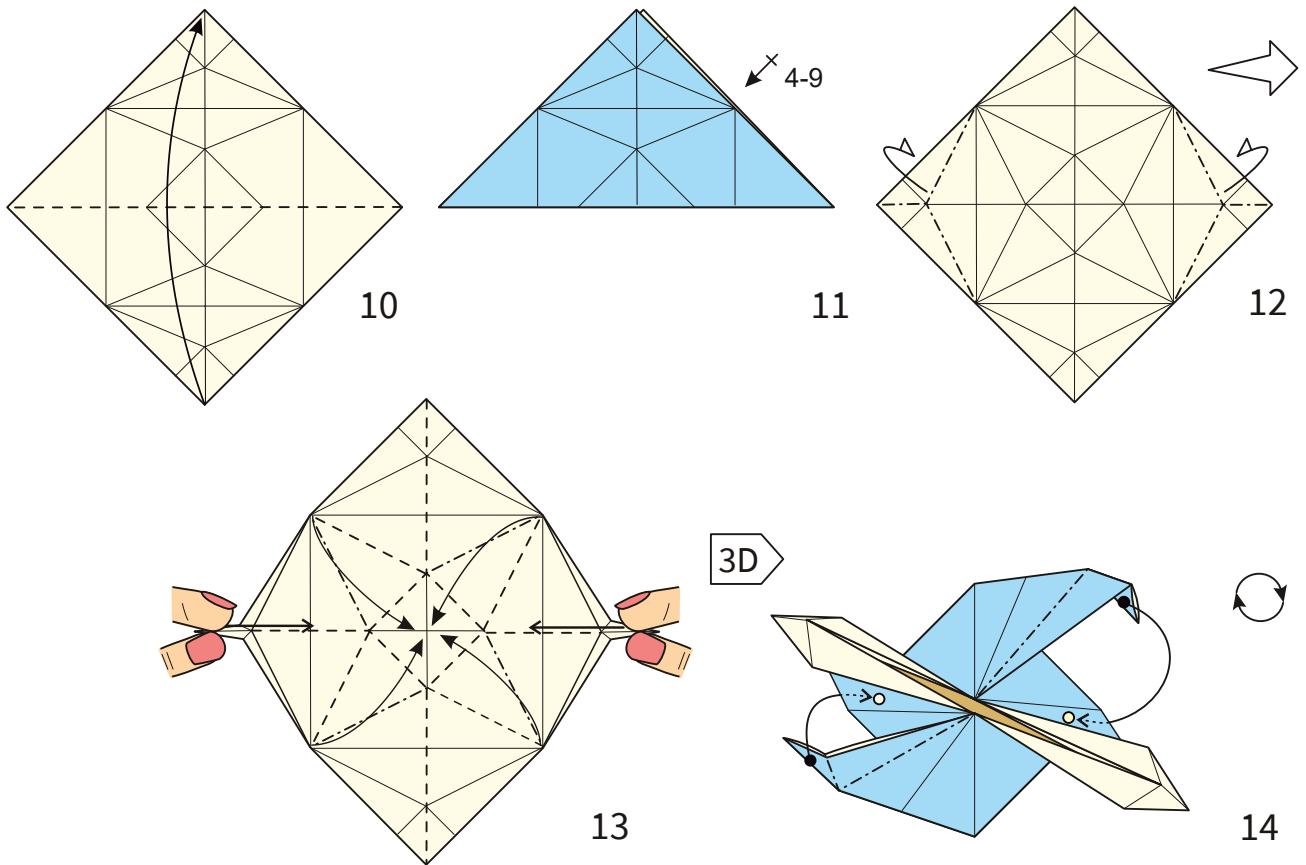


The Magic Duo Color Box is a beauty and one of my favorites. In the last step it gets it's shape, color change, sturdiness, and lock. The lock is surprising and invisible.

I love this practical model which is especially beautiful folded from double-sided paper or other special paper, like braille- or embossed paper. And, of course, there are several variations possible.

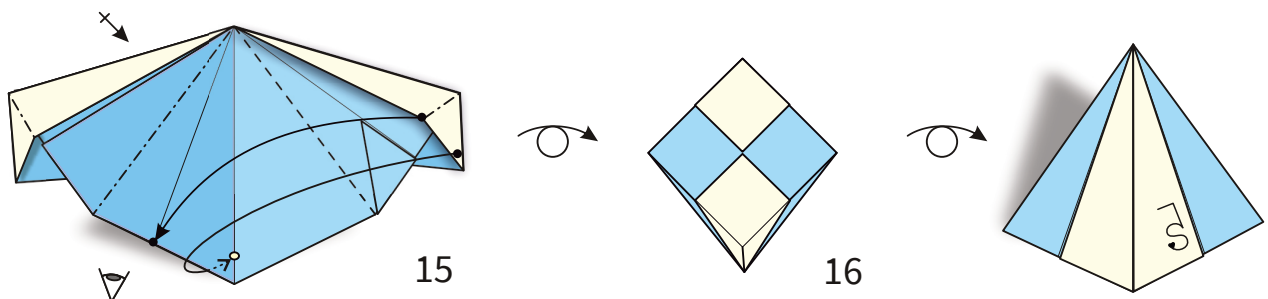
Paper:
- 15x15 cm duo color





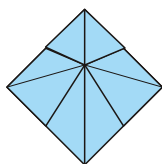
Hold the opposite corners and push them inwards together.

Wrap the small corners behind the paper flaps with the colored corners.

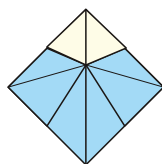


Wrap the remaining flaps around the pyramid like a windmill and slide the corners over the bottom corners.

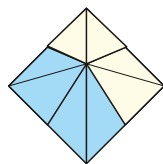
Variations at step 12



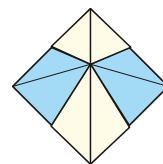
0 corners turned over



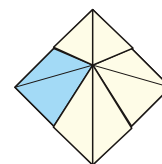

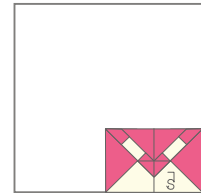
Envelopes are always useful. If not for just the pleasure of folding them at least to use them for sending a friendly greeting.

Of course you can also use them to wrap a small gift.

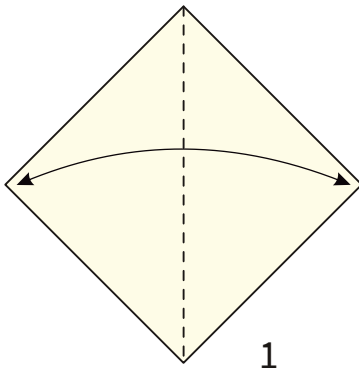
I am sure everyone can use a heartfelt one, so I recommend this chapter for that purpose.

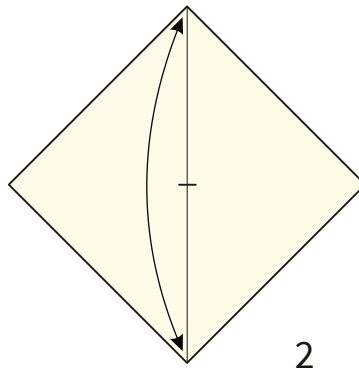

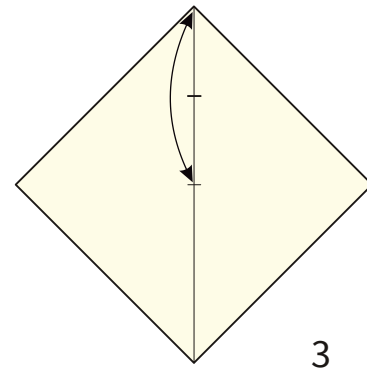
Colored side becomes the heart



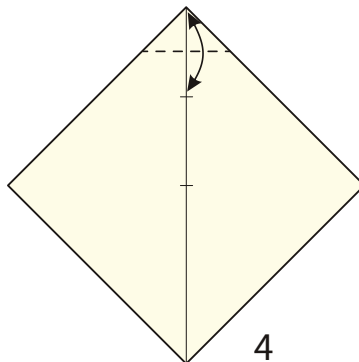

Heart Envelope

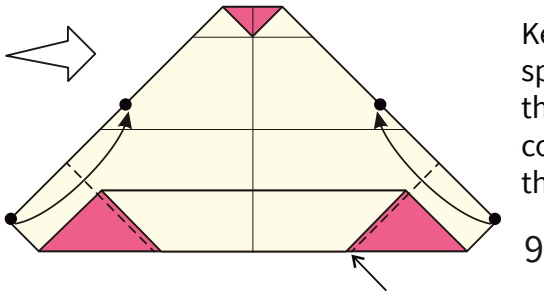

Hold both paper layers securely before Folding.

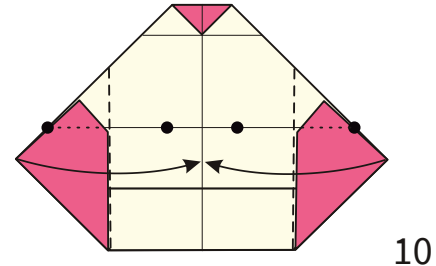
