## Lizard

Model \& Diagram Jens Kober, 2011/2020
Use a $10 \times 10 \mathrm{~cm}$ paper for a 9.5 cm long lizard.



1. Start with the colored side up. Use your favorite method to divide the paper into 5th.

2. Fold and unfold four $45^{\circ}$ angles. Unfold the paper completely and turn it
3. Add a few more valley folds. Enlarged view.

2. Divide into 10th. Turn over.

3. Fold both sides in.

6. Add the indicated mountain folds and collapse (straightforward box pleating).

7. Enlarged view of the leg.
8. Inside reverse fold the toes.

9. Slightly spread the toes.

10. Repeat steps 8 . and 9 . on the other three legs.

12. Enlarged view of the head.

13. Push the top layer up from below and close the body again. The sides of the head will be perpendicular to the top. Fold the white lines only lightly.

15. Enlarged view of the tail.

18. Back to original view.

21. Shape the neck, tail, and legs.

19. Push up the body similar to step 13.

11. Unfold the central valley fold.

14. Completed head.

17. Fold the other corner over and put into the pocket.

20. Push up some more paper from the sides of the body.
