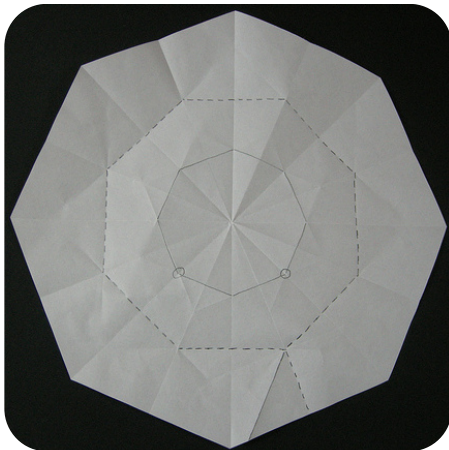
**1.** Octagon, color up.  
Easiest way to find the 1/3 is creasing it on the square before cutting the octagon.



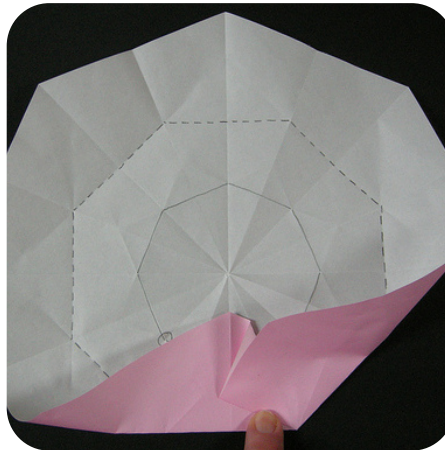
**2.** Crease an octagon using the 1/3 mark.  
Flip over.



**3.** Move a corner towards the center, stop when adjacent edges touch corners of the octagon, crease only the middle part. Repeat 7x.



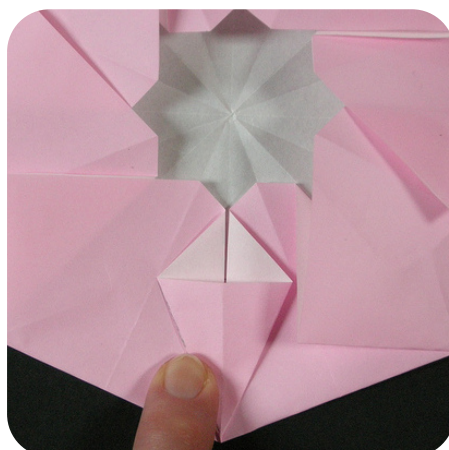
**4.** Step 3 completed.  
Showing CP for next step.



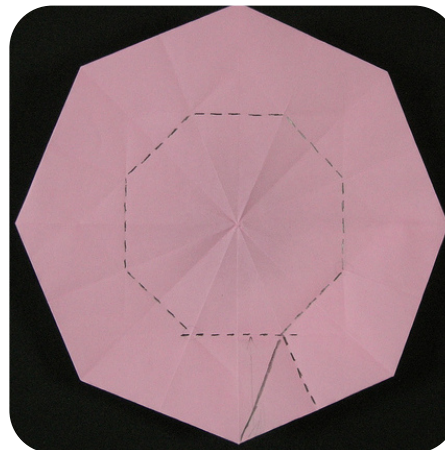
**5.** Rabbit-ear  
Repeat 7x



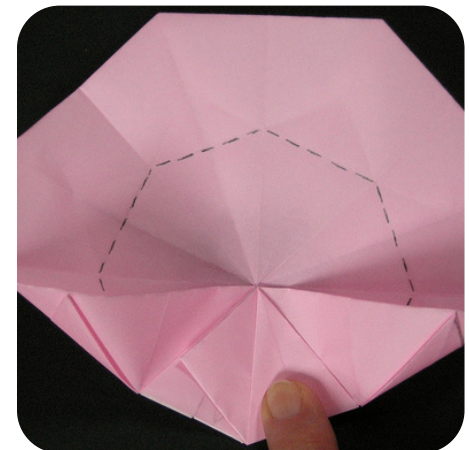
**6.** Lift one flap and bisect it



**7.** Squash flap.  
Repeat steps 6-7 on the other flaps.  
Flip over.



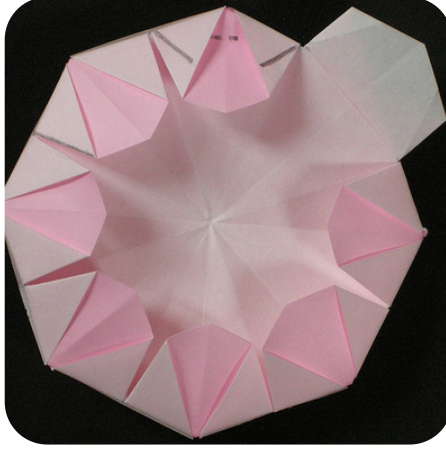
**8.** This is the octagon from step 2.  
Showing CP for next step.



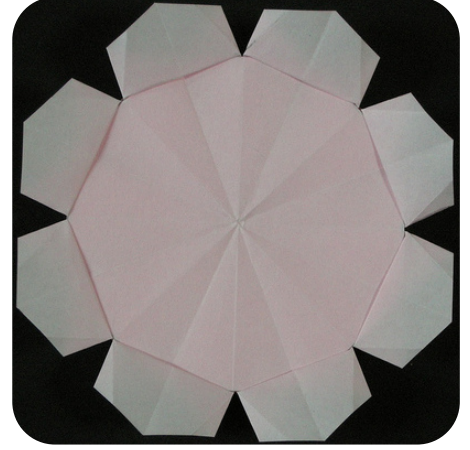
**9.** Rabbit-ear, corner to the center.  
Repeat 7x.



**10.** Step 9 completed.  
Flip over



**11.** Lift a point, open and squash.  
Repeat 7x.



**12.** Step 11 completed.  
Flip over.



**13.** Locate the squashed flap from  
step 7 (now upside-down), fold one  
half to the left. The lower part of it is  
no more flat.



**14.** Valley-fold, starting from the  
corner of the paper, going as far as  
you can.



**15.** Valley-fold completed, now it is  
flat again.



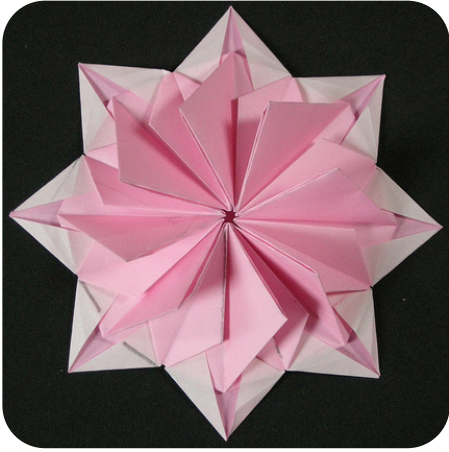
**16.** Fold the half-flap back in place.



**17.** Repeat steps 13-16 on the left  
part of the flap.



**18.** One flap completed.  
Repeat steps 13-17 on the 7 others.



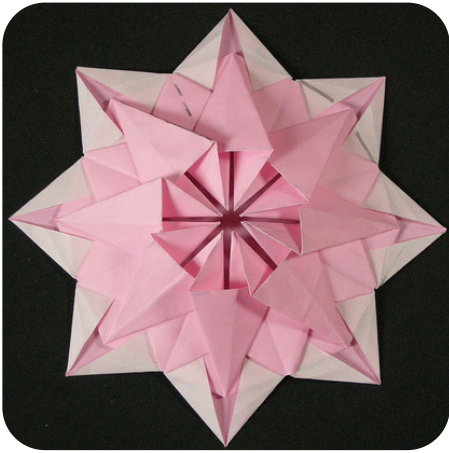
19. Step 18 completed



20. Lift a flap from step 10, bisect.



21. Squash flap.  
Repeat step 20-21 on the other flaps



22. 8 flaps completed



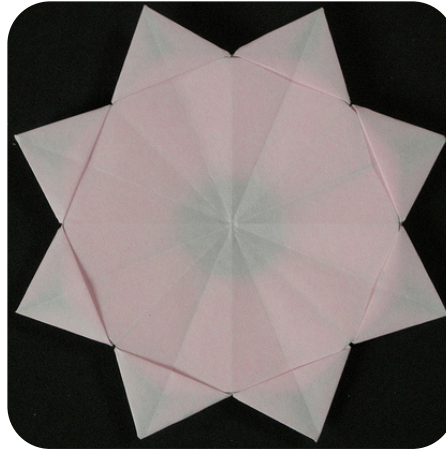
23. Lift the little points in the center.



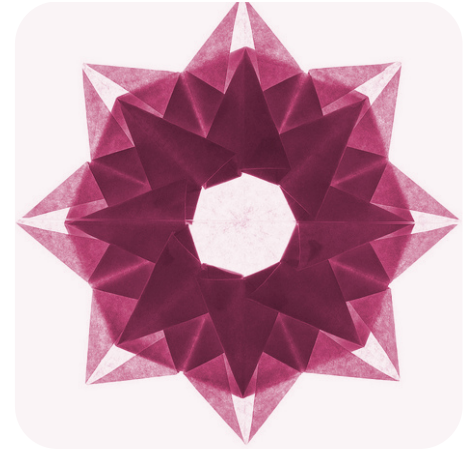
24. Tuck points inside flaps.  
This will lock the model.
