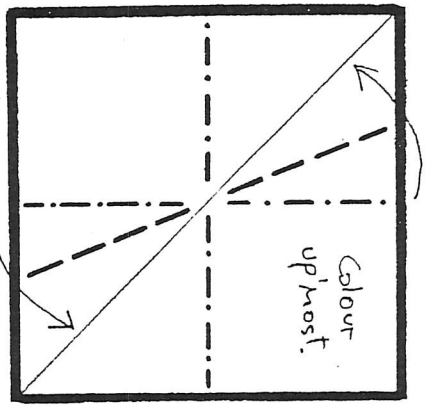
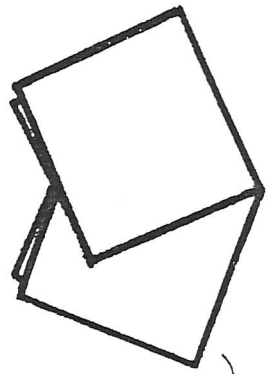


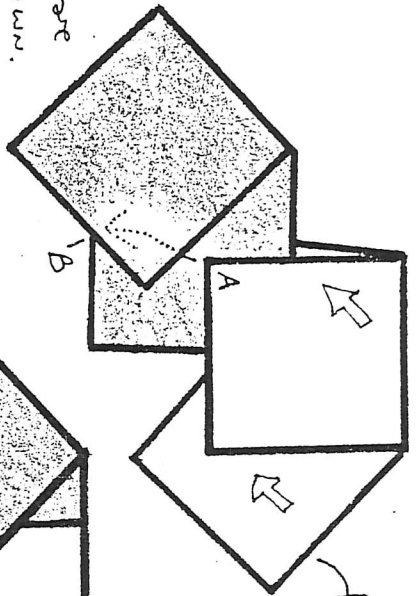
# Coaster 4.



1 Fold a small square of paper as shown. The valley crease bisects the angles between the vertical mountain crease and the diagonal.

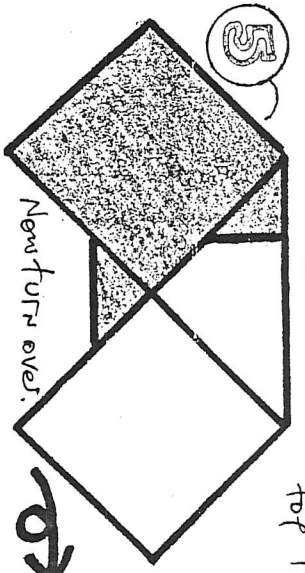
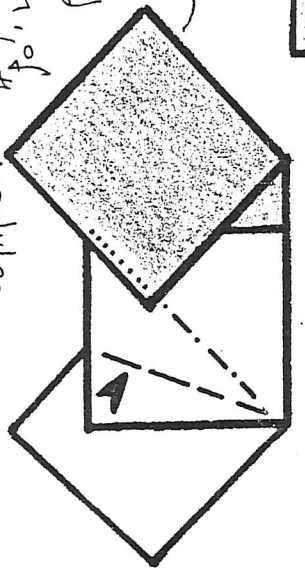


2 A mod:ried prelim: nary base. Make a total of eight, similarly sized + of different colours.

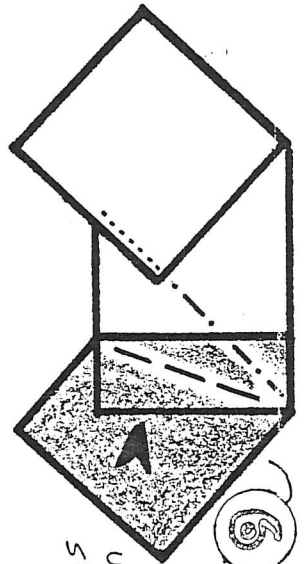


3 Position one unit inside a second. Corner A meets point B.

As shown, fold top layers only of both modules.



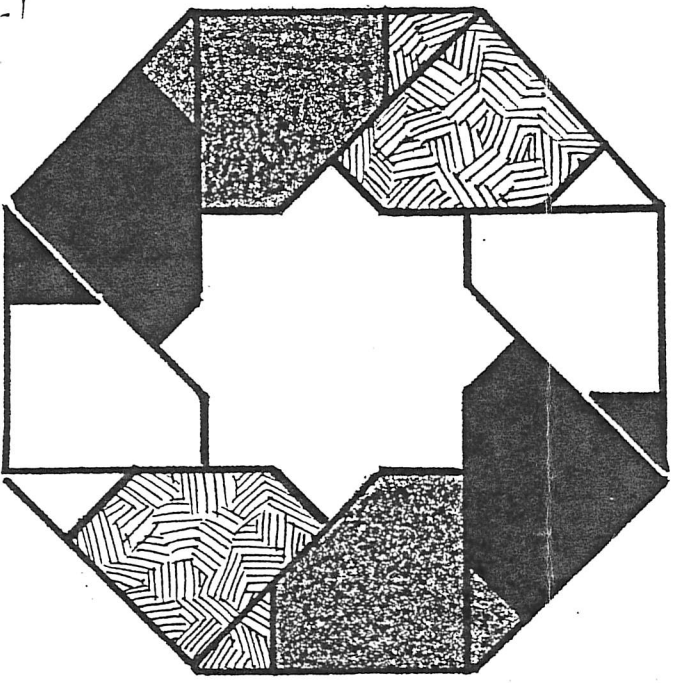
New turn over.
