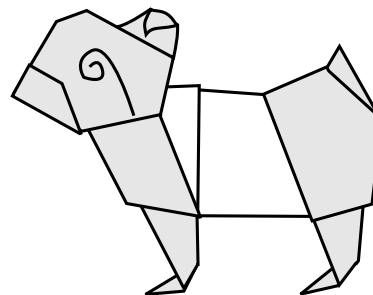

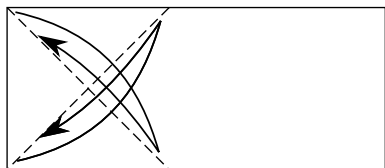

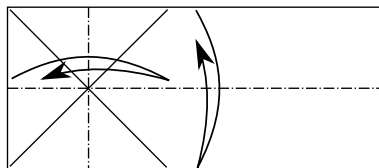
Shaded area represents the green side of the bill. Start with green side down to get eyes.

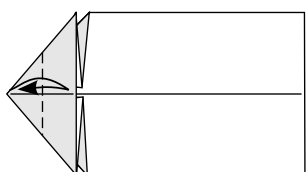

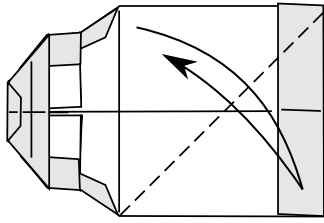

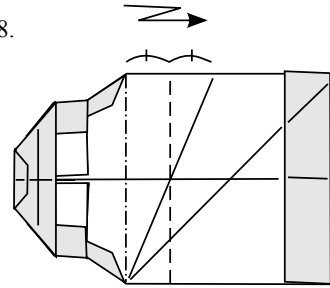

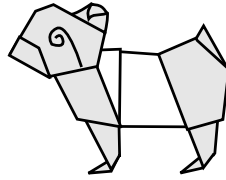
