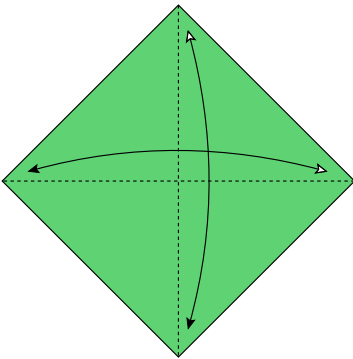
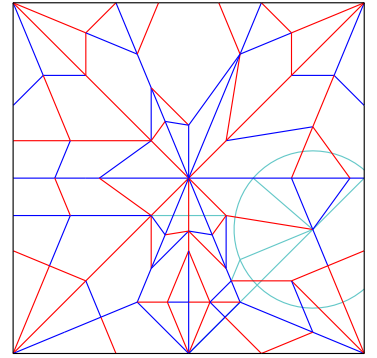


Dragon Fruit - Sam Hesp

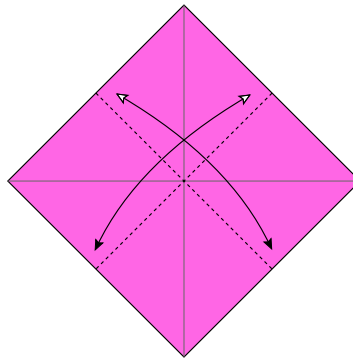
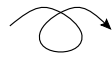


Description: This model is folded from a square base. For the correct colour change, start with the green-side up. The other colour depends on the variety of dragon fruit you wish to fold. Good options include pink, red, and yellow.

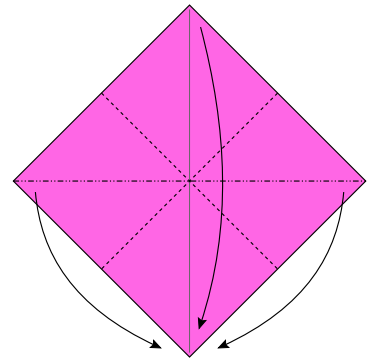
Recommended paper size: 20 cm x 20 cm



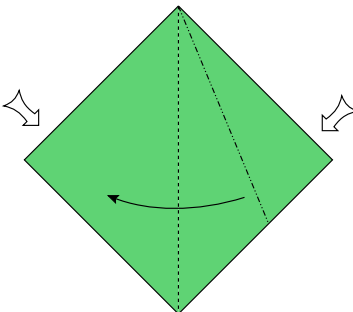
1. Fold and unfold along diagonals. Turn over.



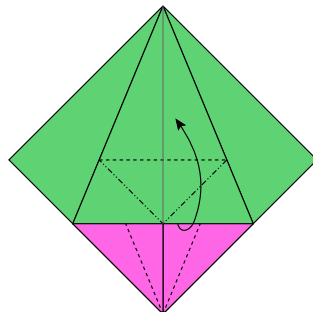
2. Fold and unfold lengthways.



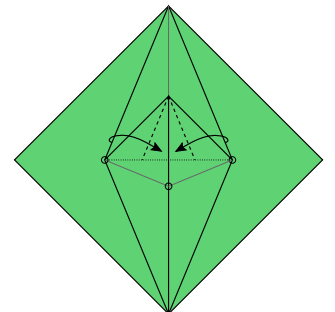
3. Make a preliminary base.



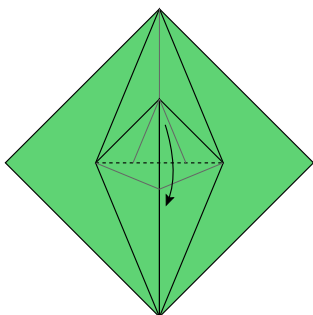
4. Squash fold the near right flap. Repeat behind.



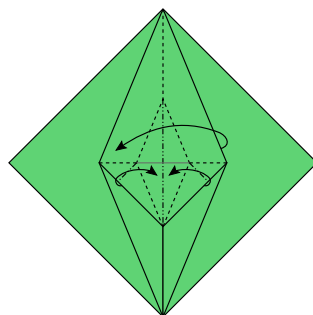
5. Petal fold the front side only.



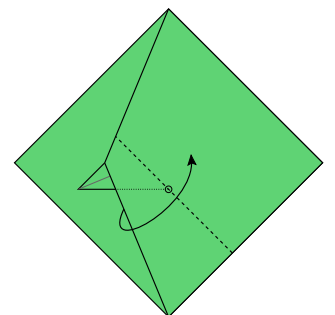
6. Fold on angle bisectors through two layers, stopping at the dotted line.



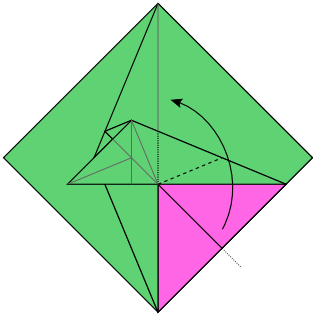
7. Fold the flap down.



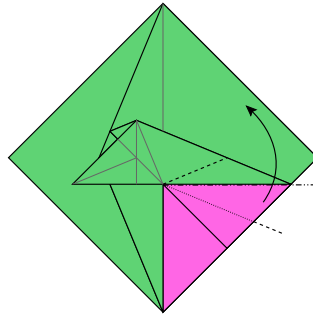
8. Collapse and fold to the right.



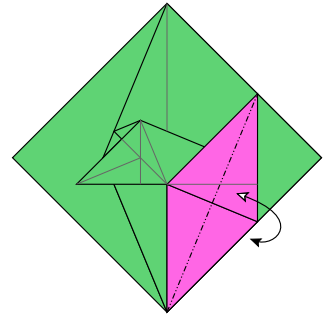
9. Fold one layer upwards as far as it goes.



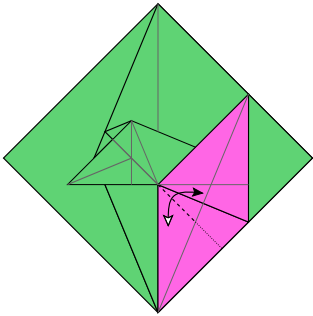
10. Fold an angle bisector, creasing only the top flap.



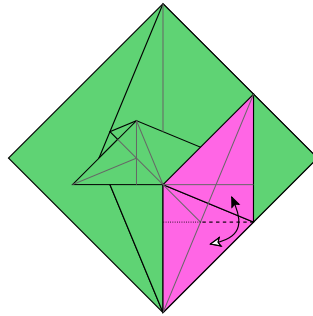
11. Swivel the corner on the crease you made in the last step.



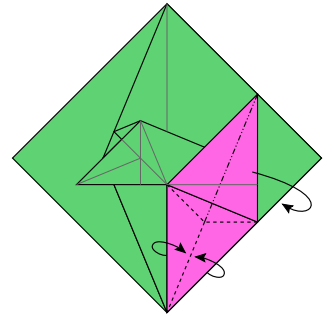
12. Mountain fold on the angle bisector, creasing through all layers.



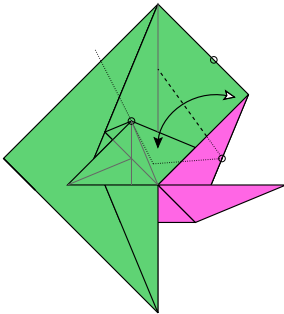
13. Fold the flap against an existing crease. Don't fold past the centre.



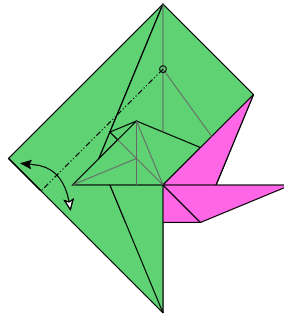
14. Fold the flap against the edge beneath. Don't fold past the centre.



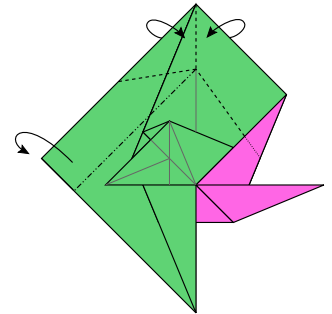
15. Outside reverse fold on existing creases and fold down a flap.



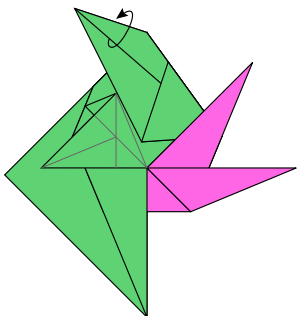
16. Fold an edge to a point swiving from a pivot.



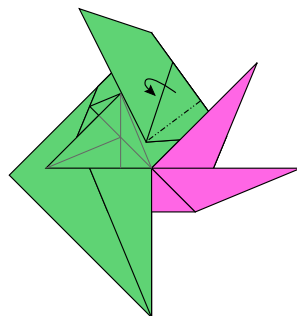
17. Mountain fold and unfold through all layers, perpendicular to the edge.



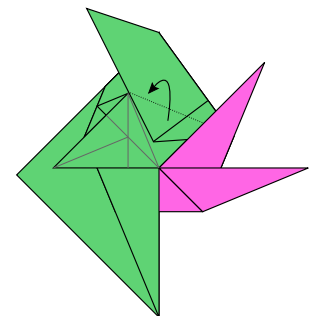
18. Collapse as shown.



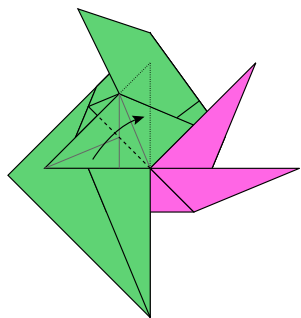
19. The model should look like this. Unwrap a layer.



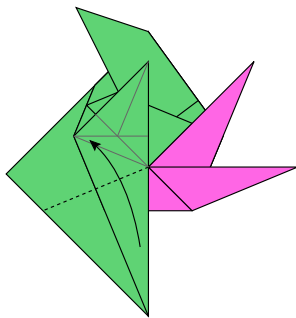
20. Mountain/reverse fold behind on an angle bisector.



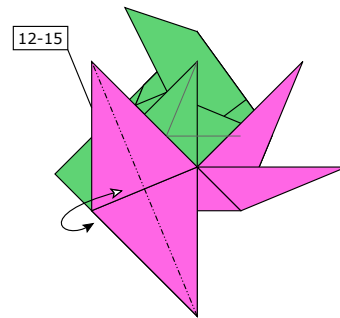
21. Tuck the flap inside..



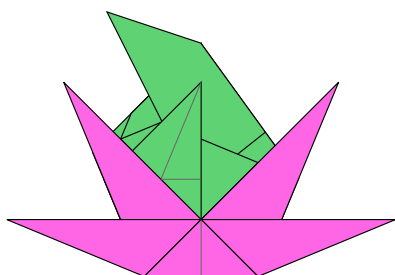
22. Fold a flap up.



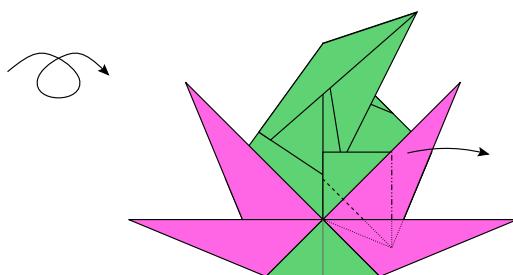
23. Fold another flap up along an angle bisector.



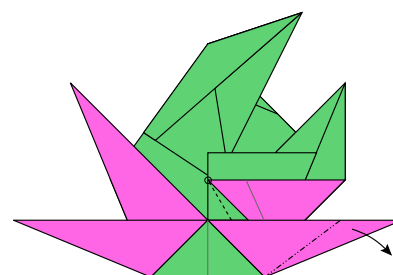
24. Repeat steps 12-15 on the left side.



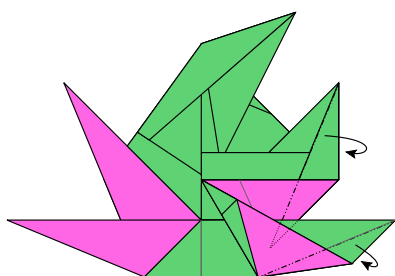
25. Like so. Turn the model over



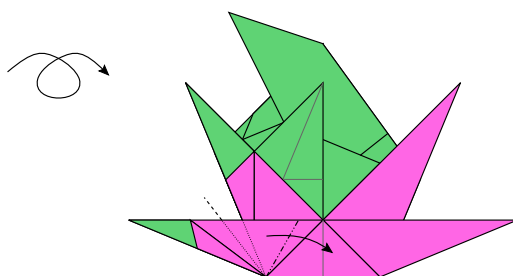
26. Swivel the flap to the right so it is parallel with the base.



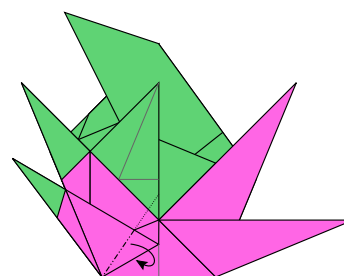
27. Swivel again, this time from the circled point.



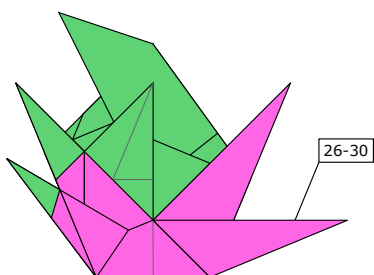
28. Mountain fold. Turn over.



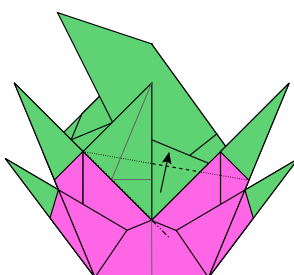
29. Like so. Swivel the flap so it lines up with the flap above it.



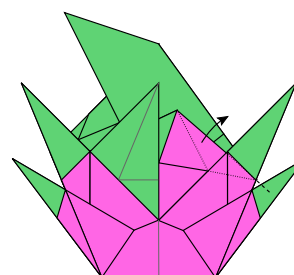
30. Mountain fold inside to lock.



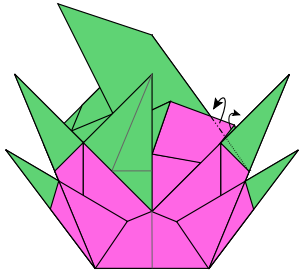
31. Repeat steps 26 to 30 on the other side.



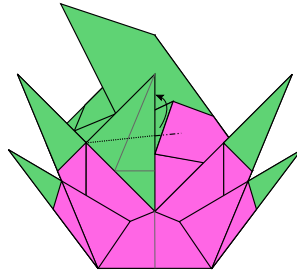
32. Reverse fold.



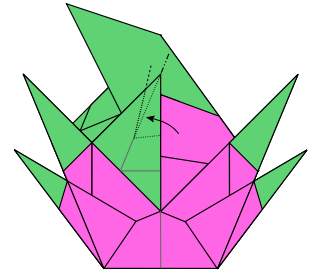
33. Pull out a flap.



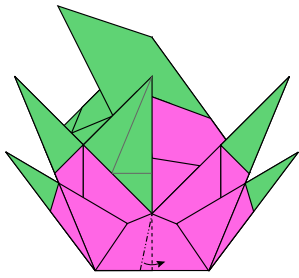
34. Mountain fold behind to lock, releasing the extra paper.



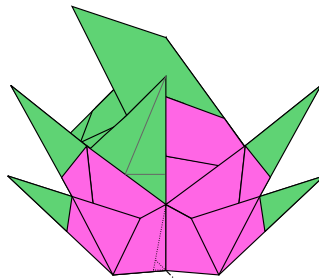
35. Swivel the corner.



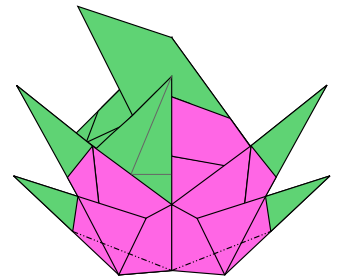
36. Reverse fold.



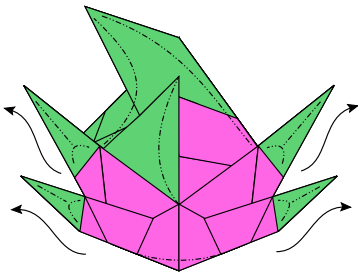
37. Crimp to make the model 3D.



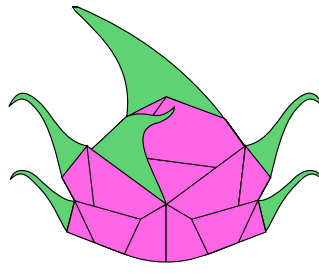
38. Mountain fold to form a small triangle to lock.
